

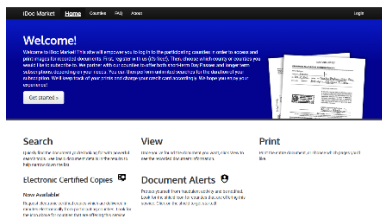
Records in the Ralls County Recorder of Deed's office are now available to search and/or purchase copies online through iDoc Market! In addition to viewing documents online, you can now sign up for fraud alerts for your property with Document Alerts!

This service was made possible by a grant from the Missouri Secretary of State's office. Document Alerts is a free service that allows a property owner to receive notifications directly to their email when a document is recorded based on the criteria set up by each individual. The Recorder of Deed's office does not set up or monitor your account with iDoc Market.

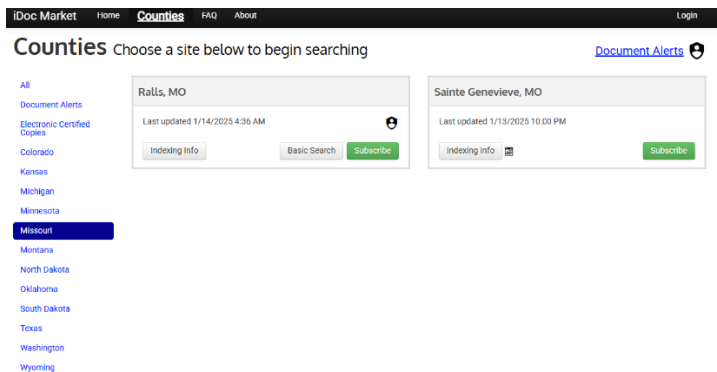

To view Recorded Documents online go to idocmarket.com

Click on the grey "Get Started" box under "Welcome!". This will take you to a new screen.



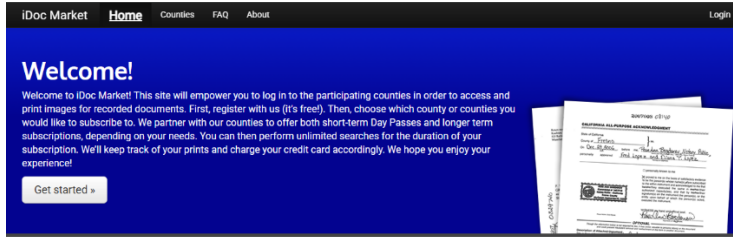
Select "Missouri" in the list to the left of the screen.



Then select the Green "Subscribe" button under "Ralls, MO" to choose which type of viewing pass you want or click the grey "Basic Search" button if just wanting to see what has been recorded instead of purchasing copies.

To sign up for Doc Alerts, go to idocmarket.com

Click on the icon next to "Document Alerts". This will take you to a new screen. If you already have an account, login on the left or create a new account on the right.



Search

Quickly find the document you're looking for with powerful search tools. See basic document details in the results to help narrow down the list.

Electronic Certified Copies

Now Available!

Request electronic certified copies which are delivered in minutes electronically from participating counties. Look for the icon above for counties that are offering this service.

View

Once you've found the document you want, click View to see the recorded document information.

Document Alerts

Protect yourself from fraudulent activity **not be required**. Look for the shield icon for counties that are offering this service. Click on the shield to get started!

Print

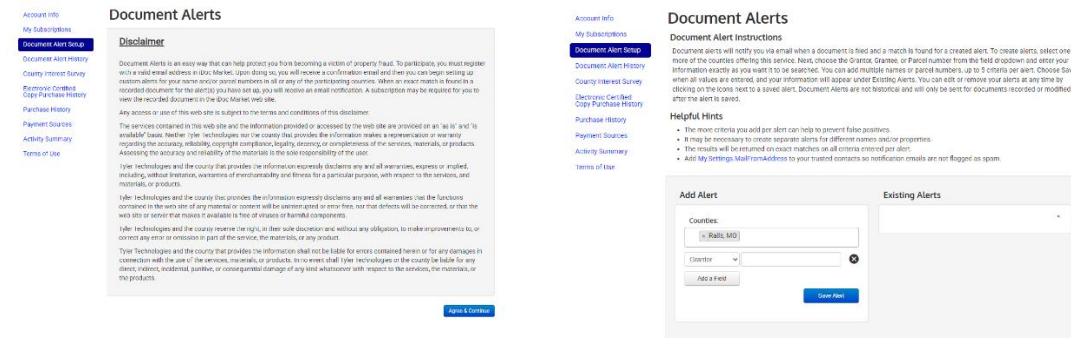
Print the entire document, or choose which pages you'd like.

Once you enter your email, it will send you a link. You will create your login with password and register. This will take you back to the login screen. SKIP the survey that pops up.

Now that you have created your account and logged in, you will select Missouri then Ralls County.

Click on your account in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Select Doc Alert Setup to the left. Click "Accept & Continue" This will take you to a new screen. Follow the instructions at the top of the page.



There is a spot that offers you a place to enter your parcel number - DO NOT SELECT PARCEL # !

Document Alerts

Document Alert Instructions

Document alerts will notify you via email when a document is filed and a match is found for a created alert. To create alerts, select one or more of the counties offering this service. Next, choose the Grantor, Grantee, or Parcel number from the field dropdown and enter your information exactly as you want it to be searched. You can add multiple names or parcel numbers, up to 5 criteria per alert. Choose Save when all values are entered, and your information will appear under Existing Alerts. You can edit or remove your alerts at any time by clicking on the icons next to a saved alert. Document Alerts are not historical and will only be sent for documents recorded or modified after the alert is saved.

Helpful Hints

- The more criteria you add per alert can help to prevent false positives.
- It may be necessary to create separate alerts for different names and/or properties.
- The results will be returned on exact matches on all criteria entered per alert.
- Add [My.Settings.MailFromAddress](#) to your trusted contacts so notification emails are not flagged as spam.
