
The Ralls County Commission signed a letter to express support for Housing Preservation for a grant for North East Community Action Corporation.

Our school year has wrapped up for the 2018-2019 school year. I am writing to express in my 18 years of administration, adding a School Resource Officer has been one of the best decisions I have had the pleasure of being a part of for a school district.

The addition of Deputy Chris Walatka to our school day has benefited Ralls County R-II in numerous ways.

- Students now have an additional male role model to go to for advice, to share concerns and to make a personal connection.
- Parents no longer come to school in a threatening manner.
- Parents feel additional security for their children knowing an SRO is on site each school day.
- Administrators feel safe to follow policy and dole out discipline as necessary.
- Administrators now have an additional confidant to discuss sensitive student issues and to gain advice.
- Faculty appreciate a deputy being available for discussions in class, scenario conversations and knowing a faster response is on site should a crisis occur.
- School board members consistently hear support in the community for this program addition to our school.



RC Harlow made a motion to appoint Jody Ketsenburg to the Library Board. John Lake seconded the motion. Motion passed.




State Representative, Jim Hansen came in and updated the Ralls County Commission about things happening in the area.
