**SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
PROPOSITION SAFE SCHOOLS,
STRONG COMMUNITY**

Shall the Board of Education of the Van-Far R-I School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete safety and security improvements including a new High School entrance and Elementary School intercom system; to install new heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems at the High School and Elementary School gymnasiums; to abate and install new flooring in hallways at the High School; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6109 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
